



Brockton Educational Talent Search Scholarship Application Instructions

Overview

The Brockton Educational Talent Search Program operated by American Student Assistance® (ASA) will ask ASA® associates, BTS students and the Brockton Community to contribute to our scholarship fund. Two students chosen will receive \$1000.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Brockton Educational Talent Search Scholarship Award, an applicant:

1. Must be an active participant in the Brockton Educational Talent Search Program.
2. Must be:
 - a. a senior at Brockton High School and must be seeking admission to an accredited college or university; or
 - b. a first-year student already enrolled in a Bachelor's Degree program at an accredited college or university.

and

3. Must participate in the Brockton Educational Talent Search Community Service Event. We will provide more details about the community service event we have planned when we receive your application.

Application Requirements

1. All applicants must meet the eligibility requirements above and **must submit the following by March 26, 2021**:
 - A. Completed application form.
 - B. One letter of recommendation from a Guidance Counselor or Teacher at Brockton High.
 - C. Official transcript from high school or college.
 - D. A typed essay of 300 words answering one of the following two sets of questions:
 - Why do you want to attend college? What is/was your motivation for making this choice and how will it enhance your life while attending and after graduation from college?
 - Discuss why it is important for you to use each opportunity afforded you to better yourself and your community? Share a personal experience about how you have already used an opportunity or plan to use your postsecondary education to create the life you envision for yourself.
 - E. Copy of processed Student Aid Report from FAFSA (www.fafsa.ed.gov) with information summary.
 - F. Confirmation acceptance letter from an accredited college or university you will be attending or an official transcript of first semester grades if already enrolled in a Bachelor's Degree program at an accredited college or university.

Selection Process

ASA will review all applications and select one winner who ASA believes, in its sole discretion, best demonstrates a strong academic foundation, consistent attendance and positive behavior in school. The student must be focused, hard-working, open to feedback and willing to commit to their education no matter the cost. The student must demonstrate academic excellence, commendable character and active engagement in program activities and show a desire to give back to their community.
